Re: Notice of Planned Decisional Classification for “Reliability Demand Response Resource Bidding Enhancements”

Any objection by the Chairs to this decisional classification is due by March 8, 2022.

This is formal notice of ISO Management’s decisional classification for the “Reliability Demand Response Resource Bidding Enhancements” initiative. Any objection by the Chairs to the decisional classification is due by March 8, 2022. Otherwise, this initiative will be presented for decision consistent with the classification described below.¹

This initiative falls within the joint authority of the Board of Governors and the WEIM Governing Body. The tariff changes to implement this initiative would be “applicable to EIM Entity balancing authority areas, EIM Entities, or other market participants within EIM Entity balancing authority areas, in their capacity as participants in EIM.” WEIM balancing authority areas may use the RDRR model assuming they have approval from their local regulatory authority and meet the requirements of RDRR participation.

Stakeholder comments on the draft final proposal were due on February 16, 2022. There were no objections to the decisional classification in the draft final proposal.
