# WSPP Schedule C Arrangements

- Questions to consider and for parties to weigh in;
  - What are do these Arrangements look like?
    - Firm Energy, do not economically curtail
  - When is the source and transmission path known?
    - Timing varies; details are known no later than 1500 day prior to flow date
  - Is the delivery point to the system static or dynamic?
    - POD is known upon execution of agreement
      - POD is static for duration of agreement?
  - Level of certainty around these MWs being delivered?
    - Most parties referred to these arrangements as reliable

## WSPP Schedule C Arrangements continued

- How would these arrangements be reflected to appropriately account in the evaluation?
  - ISO: Need a bid (self schedule) reflected at point of delivery with an associated MW volume.
- Is this feasible based on what we know regarding these arrangements up to this point?

# Import Resource Adequacy

- Import RA consists of;
  - Load serving entity must hold import allocation
  - Comes with a must offer obligation for supplier
  - May be resource specific of system
  - My understanding is, that these import RA contracts are as highly reliable as WSPP Schedule C arrangements
- Want to ensure these also make sense to be treated similarly to WSPP Schedule C?

# RSE Failure Consequences

To the extent an Entity fails the RSE; what actions should be taken?

- Limiting participation of transfers
  - If any hour fails, the current thought from the ISO is to limit the failed hour to the Bucket 1 Transfer limit
  
- Financial penalties
  - Hourly / Daily assessment
  - Frequent failures / Progressive penalties?
