Energy Storage Bid Cap is not aligned with FERC Order No. 831			
<b>Please provide a summary description of the issue (i.e. 500 words)</b>			
Currently, energy storage resources are only able to bid up to the soft bid cap of \$1,000 MWh. FERC Order No. 831 raises the soft bid cap of \$1,000/MWh to a hard bid cap of \$2,000/MWh when costs-based offers can be verified, or the CAISO calculated maximum inertia bid price exceeds \$1,000/MWh. SCE is requesting CAISO to align the energy storage resources bidding parameters with FERC Order No. 831.			
<b>Please provide any data/information available that would characterize the importance or magnitude of the issue.</b>			
Energy Storages resources should not be treated differently from other resources, putting them at a distinct disadvantage when market prices exceed \$1,000 MWh. Their bidding opportunity should be the same as other resources that are able to properly reflect their costs when market prices rise.
