Cap and Invest Rulemaking

Ecology is proposing a new rule, Chapter 173-446 WAC, Climate Commitment Act Program. The purpose of this rulemaking is to implement parts of the [Climate Commitment Act](#). In May 2021, the governor signed the Climate Commitment Act which established a cap-and-invest program to help achieve Washington's greenhouse gas limits by 2050.

This rulemaking will establish a structure for the cap-and-invest program.
